Investigations/Significant Events:

- 4/03 – Theft of gas at Luke’s Chevron. Subject located, paid for fuel.
- 4/03 – Assault report taken for a 17 year old male who assaulted a 15 year female. Male arrested for assault. Case sent to DA.
- 4/03-4/04 – At about 2200 hrs a BPD officer observed a vehicle in the Cibolo Creek in the 7600 blk of FM 1863 with several subjects standing outside vehicle.
