Investigations/Significant Events

4/01 - Fake \$20 bills being passed in the area. CID coordinating with Feds and Comal County. No Update information to report.

4/02 - Burglary of Vehicle-Home Depot. Employee's vehicle was burglarized. No new information to report.

4/05 – Assault Family Violence Hwy 281. Subject was assaulted by his spouse while driving on Hwy 281. Actor was arrested for assault family violence.

4/05 – Evading Arrest FM 1863. Dispatched for shots fired on FM 1863. Vehicle was located and attempted to flee from officers. Two subjects were arrested and a shotgun was recovered after being thrown from the vehicle.

4/12 – Attempted Suicide - Subject took an unknown amount of prescription medication and was transported to the hospital by EMS. UpDate-Patient survived.

4/14 – Attempted Suicide- Subject took an unknown amount of prescription medication and was transported to the hospital by EMS. UpDate-Patient survived.

4/15 – Aggravated Assault-Bulverde Business District. Several male subjects involved in an altercation outside a local business. Update-Warrant issued and arrest made.

4/15 – Hit and Run MVA Hwy 281. Minor damage involving three vehicles. A partial LP was obtained and is under investigation. No new information.
4/16 – Search Warrant Execution-Bulverde Hills. Possession of possible stolen property. Two flatbed trailers were seized. UpDate-Seizure action in process. CID
4/18 – Reckless Driver Hwy 281. Two cars were stopped for reckless driving. Three arrests made.
4/23 - Accident 3500 block FM 1863. A disabled school bus that was being towed became unsecured. The bus swung to the south side of the roadway taking out several hundred feet of guard rail, along with several hundred feet of barbed wire fence. There were no injuries, and no occupants on the school bus. 761 completed an accident report. TXDOT, and Comal ISD both made scene.
4/24 – Theft of Service at local business. Complainant and actor came to an agreement and settled the dispute.
4/25 - Crime Stoppers Annual Rally-Attended by Staff and City Administrator.
4/27 – Disturbance- Bulverde Hills. Subject was upset and out of control, causing injury to himself. Subject was transported to hospital for evaluation.
4/28,29 – Scheduled firearms training and qualification for all officers.
4/28 – Routine traffic violation Hwy 281. Upon contact with the driver it was determined the subject was off his required medication. Transported to the hospital by EMS for an evaluation. Reported theft of campaign signs during the month. No suspects identified.
