Investigations/Significant Events

8/02 – Misc Incident-Oakland Estates. A parked vehicle rolled out of a driveway striking another unoccupied vehicle which was parked across the street.

8/02-8/07 – BPD assisted with traffic control during construction on FM 1863.

8/03 – Hospice Death OVN. 45 year old male passed away while under Hospice care.

8/04 – BPD gave a presentation to a group of 8-9 year old Boy Scouts.

8/06 – Theft \$50-500 Monteola Development. Reported theft of a compressor from an A/C unit. Currently no suspects.

8/08 – Theft \$50-500 Subway. Complainant states she left her purse at Subway and upon returning, her telephone was missing. No suspects identified.

8/08 – Assigned Warrant Service Duty. BPD collected on several warrants in and around the city.

8/10- Assist CCSO- FM 1863- overdose. CCSO requested assistance. Made contact with subject that had taken pills, and had been drinking all day. Subject detained. Investigation was turned over to CCSO when they arrived.

8/11 – BPD attended Oakland Estates HOA meeting.

8/11 – Criminal Mischief \$50-500 Bulverde Crossing. An officer observed freshly painted graffiti on the rear of a business. Currently there are no suspects.

8/12 – Assisted with children’s event at BSBL. Last event for the summer.

8/12 – Evading Arrest -Hwy 46. BPD stopped a vehicle for driving without headlights. Driver got out and fled on foot. Subject was not apprehended, but was later identified. Officer received a slight knee injury during the pursuit. Warrant issued and subject arrested at later date.

8/12 – Criminal Mischief \$50-500 Cragg’s Hardware. Female suspect wrote graffiti on the bathroom wall. Incident is under review, attempting to identify the suspect.

8/13 – Harassment- Persimmon Hill. Complainant had received threatening messages on a cell phone. Incident closed.

8/13 – Forgery HEB. Report of counterfeit \$10 bills. One suspect identified- case is under investigation. Federal Agency notified (SS).

8/15 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject was observed by HEB management placing a package of steaks in his pants and leaving store. Subject was cited for theft.

8/15 – Structure Fire-Residence. Assisted BFD with structure fire off of Bulverde Rd. Fire determined to be accidental.

8/17- BPD did a presentation on Scams-Bulverde Senior Center.

8/17 – BPD attended Windmill Ranch HOA meeting.

8/18 – BPD attended Oak Village North HOA meeting.

8/19 – Assist EMS Oak Village North. 91 year old male not breathing and transported to hospital. Subject passed away from apparent natural causes.

8/19 – Structure Fire-Bulverde Hills. Assisted BFD with a structure fire on Wildcat.

8/19 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. Female subject arrested for theft of items from HEB and local traffic warrants.

8/21 – Violation PO / Evading Arrest- Oak Village North. Officers dispatched for violation of a protective order. Subject ran/escaped from officers. Arrest warrant issued.

8/21 – Evading Arrest-HEB. Individual known to have a parole warrant fled on foot from BPD officers. Subject was apprehended.

8/23 – Theft \$50-500 Tetco. Subject pumped fuel and drove away. Found to be unintended. Subject returned to pay for fuel.

8/24-8/26 – BPD assisted with three school zones in the city. No incidents to report.

8/24 – Theft \$0-50 BSB EMS. Small amount of medical supply found to be missing. Possible suspect identified.

8/25 – Domestic Disturbance-Oakland Estates. Disturbance found to be verbal only. Subjects were separated for the night.

8/26 – Disturbed Person-OVN. One subject was detained and transported to hospital for an evaluation.
