***Investigations/Significant Events:***

12/01 – Burglary Habitation- OVN. Citizen arrived home to find the front door open. No forced entry. A couple of small items and alcohol were taken from the home. Several electronic items were left behind. No suspects identified.

12/01 – Forgery Oakland Estates. Citizen states she was contacted by Corpus Christi reference checks written on her account. No suspects identified.

12/02 – Sgt Simpson received the Bulverde Spring Branch Chamber of Commerce Officer of the Year Award. Attended Annual awards Banquet with 750.

12/03- Firearms Qualifications for all Officers at the Range.

12/04 – Lt Haecker represented BPD and attended SAPD Officer Robert Davis’ funeral services in San Antonio.

12/5 – Structure Fire Panther Dr. Fire in the chimney area which was extinguished with minimal damage.

12/10 – Criminal Mischief FM 1863. Two windows were broken in a vacant house. No suspects identified. 750 attended Alamo Area Police Chief’s mtg. Bulverde Municipal Court Day.

12/11 – Counterfeit Bill Hwy 46. A counterfeit five dollar bill was passed at Subway. Bill and case forwarded to Secret Service.

12/12 – BPD participated in a Career day at Arlon Seay Elementary.

12/14 – Commercial MVA FM 1863. A vehicle with an oversized load struck a power line causing a power outage in the OVN area. CPS responded and repaired the line. Accident report completed.

12/15 – Theft of Service Hwy 46. Case discussed with DA’s Office, determined to be civil matter.

12/16- Gifts delivered to Spring Branch Middle School for distribution to “Kids in Need”. Funds donated by private individual to BPD for worthy cause.

12/16 American Bank Robbery in Luling. Information distributed to Officers. Business Patrols focus on area banks. American Bank of Texas Robbery in Garden Ridge on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

12/17 – Credit Card Abuse. Complainant reported an unknown subject charged items on his credit card. Report generated for documentation. No suspects.

12/18 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject pumped \$13.00 worth of fuel and drove away. Found to be accidental subject returned and paid for fuel.

12/20 – Criminal Mischief Persimmon Hill. Unknown subjects spray painted an inappropriate image on the road. No suspects. Extra patrol assigned for area, and referred to Public Works.

12/21 – Forgery HEB. Subject passed two checks which were forged. Subject was arrested and charged with a felony. SAPD involved in investigation. Previous criminal activity by subject indicated.

12/26 – Theft HEB \$0-50. Subject pumped fuel and drove away, driver located and incident found to be accidental. Driver returned and paid for fuel.

12/27 – Domestic Disturbance FM 1863. Complainant stated her son grabbed her by her arm during a verbal argument. Actor was gone upon arrival. After review the subject was contacted and issued a citation for class “C” assault by contact.

12/27 – Transient passing through Bulverde was involved in a verbal disturbance at Exxon. Officers were called to HEB for same subject for suspicious activity. Subject eventually moved on.
