Investigations/Significant Events

12/01 – Vehicle Fire Oakland Estates. A vehicle engine fire in the 400 blk of Shadow Mountain. Vehicle was a total loss; fire was accidental, no injuries.

12/01 – Forgery HEB. Female subject presented a forged check. Subject was gone prior to arrival. Under investigation.

12/01 – Drug Overdose-Wendy’s. Subject was found unresponsive in the bathroom due to an apparent heroin overdose. EMS treated the subject and transported him to a local hospital.

12/03 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject stole a DVD and fled on foot. DVD was recovered and incident is under investigation.

12/07 – BPD attended Bulverde Hills HOA meeting.

12/08 – Burglary Motor Vehicle- Exxon Travel Mart. Complainant had items taken from her vehicle while inside the business. Vehicle was left unlocked, under investigation. Subject caught on video surveillance. Attempting to identify.

12/09 – Public Intoxication City Hall. Subject showed up to court under the influence and was arrested for PI.

12/09 – Burglary Motor Vehicle- 46 Bar & Grill. Two vehicles were burglarized in the parking lot. Under investigation.

12/10 – Firearms Training Cedar Ridge Range.

12/11 – BPD participated in a Career Day at Arlon Seay Elementary.

12/12 – Disturbance-Emerald Rainbow Fun Center. Verbal disturbance between ex-spouses. Parties were separated.

12/12 – Criminal Mischief-Bulverde Hills. Complainant discovered damage to the door lock on their vehicle. Under investigation.

12/14 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. Subject filled their vehicle with gas and drove away. LP obtained. Under investigation.

12/15 – Burglary M/V -Bill Brown Elementary. Complainant had her purse stolen from the front seat of her vehicle. Under Investigation.

12/15 – BPD attended Oak Village North-HOA meeting.

12/16 – Identity Theft- OVN. Complainant made a report for a possible identity theft.

12/16 – Firearms Training/Qualification -Cedar Ridge Range.

12/17 – BPD attended TxDOT Traffic Jam Coalition meeting.

12/18 – Burglary Habitation-Bulverde Estates. Resident returned home to find residence had been burglarized. MO matches that of several burglaries occurring in the county. Under investigation.

12/18 – Theft \$1500-20k Bulverde Estates. Citizen called to report theft of a flatbed trailer which was parked outside residence.

12/19 – Resisting Arrest-Hwy 46. Subject was stopped for speeding and found to be in possession of marijuana. While on the stop one subject ran and when caught, resisted arrest. Another subject locked the car and threw the keys to prevent entry into the vehicle. Both subjects arrested.

12/20 – Forgery HEB. Subject passed a counterfeit \$20 dollar bill. Turned over to Secret Service.

12/21 – Hospice Death -OVN. 86 year old female was in hospice care and passed from natural causes.

12/23 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. Subject was stopped while exiting the store. Subject was detained by HEB management.

12/24 – Criminal Mischief-OVN. Subject reported a rear window broken in one of his vehicles. Under investigation.

12/31 – Resisting Arrest-Hwy 281. Subject was intoxicated and in possession of marijuana and was arrested. While in route to the jail subject became violent and had to be restrained. No injuries to suspect or officers.
