***Investigations/Significant Events***

2/02 – Theft HEB. Male and female subjects entered HEB and committed theft. Subjects fled the location in a truck. LP obtained and under investigation.

2/03 – Disturbance OVN. Complainant called reference a subject at her door causing a disturbance. Complainant knew the subject and disturbance was about personal property.

2/04 – Stock Show / Rodeo Trail Ride came through Bulverde. BPD assisted with traffic for safety. No incidents to report.

2/06 – Overdose OVN. Possible suicide attempt. Subject had taken sleeping pills. EMS transported for treatment and evaluation.

2/06 – Assault 2200 blk Bulverde Rd. Complainant states he had a road rage incident with a subject on Bulverde Rd. Upon pulling over, words were exchanged and complainant states he was assaulted. Report made.

2/08 – Fire Investigation 2800 blk Barton Hill. Fire on a vacant lot, no structural losses.

2-09 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Suspects were located and a citation for class C theft was issued. Items were recovered and returned to HEB.

2/13 – Recovered Stolen Vehicle at HEB parking lot. Vehicle was reported stolen out of Dallas.

2/13 – Fraud-Citizen received a Publishers Clearing House check in the mail with instructions for cashing the check and sending partial funds to someone else. Citizen was advised this was a scam. Check was taken for investigation.

2/13 – Burglary of Motor Vehicle- OVN, SV Rd.. Two vehicles were burglarized sometime during the previous night hours (separate locations). Small items and some tools were taken. No suspects at this time. PM shift advised for extra patrol.

2/14 – Assist CCSO Hwy 46. Officers located suspect involved in an aggravated assault / robbery (County). Driver arrested and turned over to CCSO.  
2/14- Saturday. Chief participated in the Annual 5K Charity Event for the Children’s Advocacy Center of Comal County.  
2/16 – Chief attended Bulverde Hills HOA meeting Monday night. Officer Prentiss also attended. Presentation and Q&A.  
2/17 – Assault Family Violence-OVN. Subject was arrested for assaulting a family member.  
2/18 – Forgery-HEB. Subject attempted to cash a payroll check which had been forged. Vehicle was stopped on Hwy 281 where the driver was arrested on a theft warrant out of Bexar County Passenger arrested for forgery offense.  
2/21 – Saturday-Chief Hamilton and Officer Walker attended Highlands Estates HOA meeting at Bulverde Spring Branch Library. Presentation and Q & A.  
2/22 – Assist CCSO with shutting down Hwy 46 at Bulverde Rd for Airlife. Two transported Via Airlife with burns sustained in a structure fire off Grassland.  
2/23 – Chief met with the Bulverde Area Response Team-Citizen Group of Volunteers available for support during local emergencies.  
2/24 – Theft \$0-50 Hwy 46 Business. A man entered requesting gift cards and \$40 cash. He then stated he forgot his wallet and exited the store and did not return to pay. Scam under investigation.  
2/25- Chief attended Board of Director’s Mtg. for the Children’s Advocacy Center of Comal County.  
2/27 – Threat-. Subject asked bank employees to call the police stating there was a man in his car demanding he withdraw cash. One arrested for a warrant out of Bexar County and possession of a controlled substance. Investigation is ongoing.
