Investigations/Significant Events

2/01 – BPD attended Windmill Ranch HOA meeting.
2/01 – Credit Card Abuse- Bulverde Hills. Complainant advised their credit card was possibly lost and items were charged on their account without their consent. Report completed and under investigation.
2/02 – BPD-Mentor program at Bill Brown Elementary.
2/02 – Credit Card Abuse-Luke’s Chevron. Complainant advised an ex-employee used a customer’s credit card without consent. Suspect identified, case sent to DA’s Office.
2/02 – Burglary- 46 Pizza. Suspect broke a window and entered the business and committed theft. Report completed and under investigation.
2/03 – BPD-Mentor program at Rahe / Bulverde Elementary.
2/04 - Specht Rd. and Cibolo Creek- Bexar County. Deceased male found in vehicle which had washed into the creek. Investigation by Bexar County.

2/06 – Fatal Accident Hwy 46. Three car crash in the 26,200 blk of Hwy 46. F150 pulling a loaded trailer, jack-knifed and collided with a small SUV, and mini-van. One fatality, three injured. Accident not weather related. Hwy 46 was shut down for about three hours. Investigation indicates driver lost control due to trailer sway.

2/08 – Theft \$1500-20K Home Depot. Complainant reported land surveying equipment possibly stolen from truck while at Home Depot. Also stated it may have happened at SV High School. No forced entry, under investigation.

2/09 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. Subject placed items in a cart and walked out the door. Possible suspect identified, under investigation.

2/09 – Hospice Death Bulverde Hills. 87 year old female in Hospice Care passed away from natural causes.

2/09 – Disturbance- Sonic Drive Inn. Manager reported a subject causing a disturbance. Subject drove off in a reckless manner and was observed by a BPD officer. Subject arrested for Reckless Driving and Possession of Controlled Substance.
