Investigations/Significant Events

01/02 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. Subject loaded \$357.14 worth of items into a grocery cart and attempted to walk out of the store. When questioned by HEB staff he stated he was going to get his wallet. Subject arrested on a Theft warrant out of Bexar County. A warrant was obtained the following day for the theft from HEB.

01/04 – Theft \$50-500 Bulverde Oaks. Unknown subject took two cell phones while victims were playing a youth sport at a gymnasium. No suspects.

01/05 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject walked out without paying for three magazines. Citation issued for class “C” theft.

01/06 – Theft \$50-500 Bulverde Business Dist. Employee of a local business reported stolen funds from his business. Possible suspect identified.

1/10 – Theft \$0-50 Tetco. Subject pumped fuel and drove away. A license plate was obtained and the owner out of Ft Worth was contacted. Incident was accidental. Subject paid for fuel.

1/11 – Disturbance in Oakland Estates. Subject interfered with a 911 call. Subject had warrants out of Harris County for Aggravated Assault. Subject arrested and transported.

1/21 - Assist Other Agency - 22000 blk Hwy 46 – A truck was stopped on the south side of the roadway and appeared to have been involved in an accident. The driver was still inside the vehicle passed out. EMS responded and checked subj. Comal County Deputies subsequently arrested subject.

1/24 – San Antonio Roadrunners Association Annual 25k run. Officers assisted with traffic safety for the event with approximately 300 runners. Event went smoothly with no incidents.

1/24 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject loaded about seven bundles of firewood and drove away. Subject was located and returned to pay for the items. Trespass warning was issued.

1/24 – Local Reporter Don Bommer road with BPD unit.

1/26 – BPD (Steve Simpson) gave presentation at Broadway Bank regarding emergency/security procedures for criminal events.

1/27 – Credit Card Fraud. Citizen reported that unknown subject(s) had obtained credit card numbers and charged goods and services (New York) to her card. Report taken.
