Investigations/Significant Events

01/01 – Resisting Arrest-Bulverde Rd. Subject was arrested for public intoxication. While in route to the jail subject became violent. More restraint was necessary. No injuries to subject or officers.

01/03 – Assault- Hwy 46. Subject states he was assaulted while at a local business. Report completed and under review. Subjects have been identified. Case will be presented to DA.

01/12 - BPD attended Council Mtg. at City Hall.

01/13 – BPD-At Rahe/Bulverde Elementary for start of mentorship program.

01/13 – Burglary M/V-Bulverde Business Dist. Subject reported a burglary of a motor vehicle which occurred about three weeks ago. Report taken.

01/13 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Suspect stole a purse from a shopper while inside HEB. Suspect was caught by citizens and detained until officers arrived. Charges filed.
