Investigations/Significant Events

7/01 – BPD attended a meeting in New Braunfels with other county officials in preparation for the digital radio transition scheduled in July.

7/01 – BPD assisted with traffic control at the BSB Library for a children’s event.

7/01 – Missing Person- OVN. A 78 year old male (medical issue) drove away from his residence and the family did not know his location. Subject was located in Kerr County and was reunited with his family.

7/01 – Theft \$0-50 Tetco. Subject walked in to Tetco and ran out with an 18pk of beer. No suspects identified.

7/03 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Suspect identified and cited for theft \$0-50.

7/05 – Burglary Motor-Vehicle Oakland Estates. Unknown subjects forced entry into a vehicle and stole some tools. Incident under investigation, currently no suspects.

7/05 – Fraud-Exxon Travel Mart. Subject called store clerk referencing problems with the prepaid telephone card system. Found to be a telephone scam.

7/06 – Structure Fire-Bulverde Oaks. Lightning struck a home causing a fire in the attic and in an upstairs room. No one was home at the time.

7/06 – The Bulverde Emergency Response Team (Volunteers) met at the Bulverde Senior Center, hosted by BPD. Mayor Jeffrey was in attendance and addressed the group. An Emergency Management program was given by Rick Tobin, a local emergency management specialist.

7/07 – Theft (Beer)-HEB. Seven suspects located, identified, and cited (theft \$0-50).

7/08 – Assisted with traffic at Bulverde Spring Branch Library for children’s event.

7/08 – Harassment-Oakland Estates. Complainant received harassing telephone calls. Suspects were identified. Handled by parents.

7/09 – Assault-Oakland Estates. Assault (not in progress) between two friends, ages 16 and 17. Incident under investigation and sent to DA’s Office for review.

7/10 – Assist BFD Hwy 281. A vehicle traveling on Hwy 281 had a blowout which sparked a small grass fire on the shoulder of Hwy 281.

7/11 – Disturbance-Bulverde Hills. Disturbance between step-son and step-father. A weapon had been displayed during the disturbance. Subjects were separated for the night. Case has been prepared and sent to DA’s Office.

7/12 – Burglary of Habitation-Bulverde Hills. Burglary of a residence, possibly done by a relative. Case is being investigated. No update.

7/12 – Assault-Oakland Estates. Complaint about reckless driver endangering children in the area. Officer addressed issue with both parties.

7/13 – Deceptive Business Practices-Oakland Estates. Complaint states victim bought a trailer on E-bay and didn’t receive the item. Case is under investigation. No update.

7/13 – Transition to Digital Radio by CCSO dispatch. All appears to be working well.

7/13 – Disturbance-OVN. Disturbance/assault- sibling quarrel. One subject arrested.

7/15 – Assist BSBL with children’s event.

7/18 – Disturbance Bulverde Hills. Disturbance between spouses. One subject was cited for class “C” assault and parties were separated for the evening.

7/18 – Criminal Mischief \$0-50 OVN. Subjects riding around in golf cart damaging signs and mailboxes. All subjects identified and cited.

7/20 – Assault OVN. Disturbance between a male and female. One subject arrested for assault, family violence.

7/22 – Assist BSBL with children’s event.

7/22 – Vehicle Fire Bulverde Hills. Mail courier vehicle caught fire while delivering mail. Property damage only.

7/22 – Assault FM 1863. Disturbance between two room mates. One subject transported to the hospital. Case sent to DA’s Office for review.

7/22 – Criminal Mischief \$50-500 Hwy 281. Subjects walking along Hwy 281 reportedly threw a rock at a passing vehicle cracking the windshield. Under investigation, currently no suspects.

7/24 – Theft HEB. Subject pumped fuel and drove away. Subject was located and returned to pay for fuel. Possibly accidental.

7/24 – Assault Family Violence FM 1863. Female was assaulted by her ex-husband while traveling on FM 1863. Suspect fled prior to officers’ arrival. Incident prepared for DA’s Office.

7/24 – Criminal Mischief-Bulverde Hills. Complainant states someone broke the realtor lock on her home which is for sale. Later discovered that the home had a showing earlier in the day and the lock was not broken.

7/25 – Theft \$0-50 Tetco. Subject pumped fuel and drove away. Vehicle was not located, incident under investigation.

7/25 – Theft \$0-50 Exxon. Subject walked in and was suspected of placing items in his pockets prior to leaving the store. Incident is under investigation, video under review.

7/26 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject pumped fuel and drove away without paying. A license plate was obtained and incident is under investigation.

7/26 – Reckless Driver Hwy 281. Officers were dispatched for a reckless driver on Hwy 281. Vehicle located and driver arrested for DWI.

7/28 – Assist CCSO. Assisted CCSO with a CMV accident in the 2100 blk of Bulverde Rd. Bulverde Rd was shut down for several hours due to overturned gravel hauler.

7/28 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Theft by an employee. Subject was issued a citation for class “C” theft and released. A criminal trespass warning was issued to ex-employee.

7/28 – Assault Family Violence-Bulverde Hills. Complainant came to the PD to report an assault which occurred a few days prior. Report completed and forwarded to DA’s Office.

7/29 – Assisted Bulverde Spring Branch Library with children’s event.
