Investigations/Significant Events:

6/03 – Harassment- Oak Village North. Domestic Problems related to divorce. Case pending at DA’s Office.

6/07 – Burglary M/V Pizza Hut. Employee who was dismissed states another employee took items from his vehicle. Suspect was cleared, case closed.

6/07 – Criminal Mischief \$50-500 at Los Encinos Restaurant. Employee states her car was “keyed”. Suspect identified & charges pending.

6/08 – Theft \$50-500 Exxon Travel Mart. Subject drove off without paying for fuel. No identifiable suspects.

6/10 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject shoplifted an item and was confronted by HEB staff. Charges pending.

6/10 – Attended Hospice Death Hwy 46. 99 year old female died of natural causes.

6/10 – Assist Other Agency. Assisted CCSO with a pursuit coming out Hwy 46. Spikes deployed but not utilized. Subject apprehended without incident.

6/11 – Harassment Windmill Ranch. Report of telephone harassment. Suspect identified & charges pending.

6/11 – Theft \$0-50 Exxon. Reported theft of beer. No identifiable suspects.

6/13 – Aggravated Robbery 29774 Hwy 281 Suite 204, at about 7:40 pm a subject entered the business and robbed an employee at gunpoint. Crime Stoppers agreed to offer an award and upon release to media several tips starting coming in. A possible suspect was located and with the assistance of San Antonio Repeat Offenders units the subject was arrested on an unrelated traffic warrant and brought to the Bulverde Police Department where he confessed to the crime. Subject is currently in Comal County Jail with a \$100,000 bond. A second subject was arrested and also charged with Aggravated Robbery as he was the subject who planned the robbery. He was placed in the Comal County Jail with a \$150,000 bond.

6/14 – Theft \$50-500, subject pumped \$90 worth of fuel at Tetco and drove off. No suspects at this time.

6/17 – Theft \$50-500, subject pumped \$62.26 worth of fuel at HEB and drove off, license plate was obtained and is being followed up on. Doesn’t look to be the correct license plate.

6/18 – Business owner wanted to report receiving two hot checks. Referred to DA’s Office hot check division.

6/21 – Bulverde PD officer attempted to stop a motorcyclist for speeding. The subject failed to yield and fled from BPD. Motorcyclist crashed on Stahl Ln. and was airlifted to University Hospital. Subject was released from University Hospital on 7/01/08. Spoke with subject’s girlfriend on 7/03/08 who stated his jaw is wired shut. No paralysis or permanent damage is apparent at this time.

6/23 – Attended Death. Subject in OVN passed away form natural causes. Hospice was on scene.

6/26 – Assist EMS. Intoxicated subject fell from a parked vehicle in Luke’s Chevron Parking lot striking his head. Subject was airlifted to University Hospital.

6/27 – Harassment Bulverde Hills. Complainant states ex-husband is harassing her. Report completed. Complainant obtained a protective order signed by a magistrate. Warrant was signed by Dib Waldrip for suspect’s arrest for making threats. Suspect was arrested in San Antonio and jailed in Bexar County.

6/29 – Structure fire in Oakland Estates. No injuries. Handled by Steve Simpson. Fire accidental.

6/30 – Forgery reported at local business. Possible suspect identified.
