***Investigations/Significant Events***

6/01 – BPD participated in a children’s event at the Kid’s Day child care facility-US 281.  
 6/01 – Runaway- Windmill Ranch. Dispatched for a runaway juvenile who returned while officer was on scene. Incident documented.  
 6/02 – Traffic incident Hwy 281. A traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle to check driver. Driver seemed disoriented & confused, stopped in roadway. While on the stop the driver backed in to the patrol car. No damage to property. Driver was given a courtesy ride to her meeting at the Library.  
 6/03 – BPD participated in a children’s event at the Bulverde Spring Branch Library. Child safety items were distributed. BPD also assisted with traffic control for citizens crossing the roadway from Home Depot.  
 6/03 – Resisting Arrest -Hwy 281. During a traffic stop on Hwy 281, a subject passenger ran from a BPD officer and resisted arrest. A citizen who observed the incident stopped and assisted the BPD officer. No injuries to the violator or officer. Violator arrested and transported to CCSO.  
 6/04 – BPD hosted the Alamo Area Police Chief’s Association’s June Mtg. Mayor Jeffrey addressed the group with a hearty welcome and introduction to the City of Bulverde.

6/07 – Missing Person Oakland Estates. Citizen reported her spouse missing. Spouse had been involved in an auto accident in another county and unable to call.

6/07 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject pumped fuel and drove away. A license plate was obtained and CID is handling the case. Subject returned to pay for fuel.

6/8- AOA- Domestic @ Quail Hill Residence. Female stabbed several males with a knife. Actor and victims not located. Victims transported by personal vehicle to hospital, stable condition, non-life threatening injuries.

6/09 – Disturbance-Bulverde Run Apts. Dispatched for a disturbance between a male and female. Dispute was verbal only-Parties separated for the evening.

6/10 – Traffic Control Bulverde Crossing. Assisted with pedestrians crossing in front of the Library for children’s event.
