Investigations/Significant Events

6/01 – Forgery / Mail Scam. Citizen reported receiving a check in the mail with instructions on cashing the check and then sending a money order to another address. Information forwarded to Postmaster.

6/02 – BPD assisted with traffic control at BSB Library summer reading event.

6/03 – Reckless Driver – Hwy 46. Caller advised of a reckless driver on Hwy 46. The vehicle was located and driver arrested for DWI 2nd offense.

6/04 – Bike patrol Hwy 46 business area.

6/04 – Leaving the Scene of an Accident – 3100 blk Bulverde Rd. Vehicle struck another vehicle in the intersection and then fled the scene. Vehicle was followed and located by deputies in the county. Driver was arrested for DWI and other charges.

6/05 – Criminal Mischief \$500-1500 – Hwy 281. Report of a car being keyed. Owner returned later in the week and signed a non-prosecution affidavit.

6/05 – Theft \$0-50 – HEB. Suspect was detained by employees for theft. BPD arrived and handled the incident.

6/05 – Disturbance – Tetco Parking lot. Officers dispatched for a disturbance in the parking lot with subjects throwing beer bottles. Upon arrival two subjects were urinating in the parking lot. Three subjects were arrested for public intoxication and MIP.

6/06 – Disturbance – Oak Village North. Officers responded for a disturbance between two adults. One subject was transported to a local hospital for MHMR evaluation.

6/07 – Reckless Damage – HEB. Witnesses called police to report a subject who pushed a shopping cart towards a corral but missed striking a vehicle. Subject identified.

6/07 – BPD attended Windmill Ranch HOA meeting.

6/08 – BPD attended Oakland Estates HOA meeting.

6/09 – Road closures FM 1863 due to high water.

6/09 – Disorderly Conduct – Broadway Bank. Customer made vulgar comments while inside the bank. Subject identified.

6/10 – Bike Patrol-Hwy 46 business area.

6/12 – Identity Theft – OVN. Subject reported unauthorized use of personal information.

6/12 – Theft \$50-500 – Bulverde Estates. Subject reported theft of cash from inside her residence. Workers were present during the time period, have been identified and interviewed.

6/12 – Disturbance – Hwy 46. Subjects traveling in vehicles were having a dispute. Subjects were stopped in the Tetco parking lot. Issue a civil matter.

6/14 – Suspicious Circumstances – Bulverde Oaks. Complaint not verified by investigation.

6/15 – BPD participated in a Children’s Vacation Bible School presentation at Hillside Fellowship Church.

6/15 – Theft \$50-500 – Bulverde Hills. Complainant reported a ring missing from inside her home. Workers were present during the time period. Workers identified and interviewed. No evidence to charge at this time.

6/15 – BPD attended OVN HOA mtg.

6/16 – BPD assisted with traffic at BSB Library summer reading event.

6/16 – BPD gave an identity theft presentation to an Edward Jones Investment group.

6/16 – Theft \$1500-20K – Bulverde Hills. Subject reported a ring which went missing on Easter. Several subjects were present inside the home due to Easter dinner. Investigation still open.

6/16 – Interfere Child Custody – Oakland Estates. Complainant reported subjects were not complying with court ordered visitation rights for his child.

6/16 – Disturbance – OVN. Dispatched for a disturbance between a male and female. Disturbance was found to be verbal only. Parties separated for the evening.

6/19 – Suspicious Circumstances – Hwy 281. A vehicle was abandoned on the side of Hwy 281. A window had been broken out and the car was doused with gasoline. Vehicle towed and stored. Reported to be stolen out of SA.

6/20 – Criminal Mischief – OVN. Complainant reported eggs being thrown at a residence and vehicles in the driveway.

6/21 – BPD attended Bulverde Hills HOA meeting.

6/22 – Mail Scam – Bulverde Hills. Complainant reported receiving a collection letter in the mail. Complainant states the information is incorrect and appears to possibly be a scam.

6/22 – Evading Arrest – Hwy 281. BPD attempted to stop a vehicle traveling 93 mph on Hwy 281. The vehicle failed to stop for officers. Vehicle was eventually located where it had run off the roadway just inside Bexar County. No driver was present. During the investigation one subject was arrested by BPD for a warrant, and one was arrested by Bexar County SO for possession of a controlled substance.
