Investigations/Significant Events

6/03 – BPD and CCSO assisted with traffic on Hwy 46 at St Joseph’s Church for Bexar County Sheriff’s Office- Sgt Vann’s funeral.

6/03 – Disturbance – Oakland Estates. Officers responded for a male causing a disturbance. Subject was transported by EMS to a local hospital for evaluation.

6/03 – Reckless Driver – Hwy 281. Complaint of a reckless driver on Hwy 281. Vehicle was located and driver was arrested for DWI, driver refused to give a specimen, warrant was obtained for a blood draw.

6/04 – Runaway – Bulverde Hills. A parent wanted to report their 15 year old as a runaway. Juvenile was entered in TCIC/NCIC. Juvenile did return home the following day.

6/05 – Reckless Driver – Hwy 281. Dispatch advised of a reckless driver on River Rd and provided a license plate number. The vehicle was later observed traveling on Hwy 281. When officers attempted to make contact, the driver pulled over and fled on foot. UTL
