***Investigations/Significant Events***

3/01 – Burglary of Building-Hwy 46, east of US 281. Suspect(s) broke the glass door making entry into a business-Theft of electronics. Under investigation.

3/01 – BPD attended Windmill Ranch HOA meeting.

3/02 – Welfare Concern-Bulverde Estates. Report of a possible suicidal subject. Contact was made with the individual. Situation stable-Subject was left in the company of her adult daughter.

3/09 – Hospice Death-Bulverde Hills. 71 year old female passed away while under Hospice care. Report completed.

3/09 – Unattended death OVN. 88 year old female was found deceased by her son. No suspicious circumstances were present. JP made the location, report completed.

3/09 – Theft \$0-50-Exxon Travel Mart. Two subjects entered the store where one grabbed a carton of beer and ran out. Subjects were located and arrested.
