***Investigations/Significant Events***

5/02 – Annual Bulverde Spring Branch Chamber of Commerce Run for the Hills 5K run. BPD assisted with traffic. Two participants sought medical attention for fatigue. BPD handed out child safety items to children in attendance.

5/03 – BPD and Mayor Jeffrey attended a First Responders Appreciation Ceremony at Heritage Baptist Church.

5/02 – Disturbance Bulverde Hills. Domestic-Verbal disturbance reference division of property. Dispute was settled without incident.

5/04 – Theft \$50-500 HEB parking lot. Complainant states someone removed tools from the back of his truck while inside HEB. No new information.

5/04 – Disturbance Hwy 281. Husband and wife having a verbal altercation while driving. Subjects were separated and one called for a ride home.

5/10 – Forgery Hwy 46. Local business received a fake \$20 bill. Information referred to US Secret Service.

5/12 – Burglary Coin Operated Machine-Hwy 46. Complainant advised his car wash had been burglarized. A picture of suspect vehicle obtained, and shared with other agencies in the area. No new information.

5/14 – Peace Officer Memorial Ceremony-City Hall. BPD annual ceremony to honor fallen officers and their families in honor of National Police Week. Staff meeting followed.

5/24 – Fire Investigation-Bulverde Oaks. Bar-B-Q coals were placed into a trash can while still hot causing the trash can to ignite. Minimal damage was sustained.

5/26 – Criminal Mischief Hwy 46. Paintballs were shot at windows on front of business. No new information.
