***Investigations/Significant Events***

5/02 – Disturbance - Oakland Estates. Disturbance between an intoxicated minor and a parent. Subject transported via EMS to local hospital.

5/03 – BPD attended Windmill Ranch HOA.

5/04 – Fire Investigation - OVN. Unknown suspect(s) started a small fire in the back yard of a residence.

5/04 – Suicidal Subject – Shepherd’s Ranch. Subject stated they had taken numerous pills in an attempt to harm themselves. Subject transported via EMS to local hospital.

5/04 – Disturbance - HEB Parking Lot. Disturbance between a male and female. Disturbance was found to be verbal only. Parties were separated.

5/05 – BPD-Mentor program Rahe / Bulverde Elementary.

5/05 – DOC Fighting - 19000 Blk Hwy 46. Several subjects were observing and video taping a fight at a business on Hwy 46. Several subjects ran upon arrival. Some were identified and cited.

5/06 – Identity Theft - Bulverde Hills. Report of a possible identity theft.

5/06 – BPD hosted the monthly Alamo Area Police Chiefs Association meeting at City Hall. Presentation by Sheriff Bob Holder.

5/08 - BPD / City Administrator participated in Annual Comal County Crime Stoppers event.

5/08 - Theft \$50-500 - HEB Construction Site. Officer took a report for stolen cedar posts. Possible suspect identified. Non-prosecution affidavit signed.

5/08 - Assault - 30000 blk Hwy 281. Officers took a report for an assault which occurred at a local business.

5/09 - Disturbance - Tetco Parking lot. Disturbance between a male and female. One subject arrested for minor consuming alcohol.

5/09 - Burglary - Bulverde Estates. BPD took a report for a possible burglary of a residence. Upon investigating the incident it was found to be a civil matter, not a burglary.

5/11 - BPD attended Oakland Estates HOA meeting.

5/11 - BPD attended mentor program at Bill Brown Elementary.

5/12 - BPD participated in a reading program at Johnson Ranch Elementary.

5/12 - Warrant Arrest - Municipal Court. Subject taken into custody for warrants.

5/13 - BPD attended TxDOT meeting in San Antonio for STEP grant.

5/13 - Staff meeting which included a short ceremony to honor law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty. National Law Enforcement week May 9<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup>. Local Minister Scott Heare assisted.

5/14 - Assist CCSO - Hwy 46. Assisted CCSO with a jack-knifed 18 wheeler on Hwy 46, just west of the city limits.

5/15 - Minor flooding on some roadways in the city. FM 1863 shut down for part of the day due to the Cibolo Creek.

5/15 - Assist CCSO - A CCSO deputy requested assistance with several subjects who were fighting, who then turned on the deputy. BPD assisted as needed.

5/15 - Disturbance - Oakland Estates. Disturbance between two family members. Disturbance was found to be verbal only. Parties were separated for the day.

5/17 - BPD attended Bulverde Hills HOA meeting.

5/17 - Firearm's Qualifications at Range.

5/18 - Suspicious Circumstances - Hwy 281 Business. BPD observed a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot of a local business after hours. Checking the business revealed a male and female subject inside the business. Subject authorized.

5/18 - BPD attended Oak Village North HOA meeting.

5/18 - Start STEP enforcement period through June 1<sup>st</sup>.

5/19 - Disturbance - Windmill Ranch. BPD night shift observed a vehicle in a driveway with doors open. Upon making contact at the residence there appeared to be a disturbance between spouses. Disturbance was verbal only, one subject left the location.

5/19 - BPD attended mentor program at Rahe/Bulverde Elementary.

5/21 - BPD attend DARE graduation at Johnson Ranch Elementary.

5/22 - Disturbance - Bulverde Hills. Officers were dispatched for a disturbance between spouses. One subject was arrested for assault family violence.

5/23 - Private Property Crash - HEB. A witness observed a subject strike an unattended vehicle and leave the area. The owner was contacted and provided a case number. Suspect vehicle was later located and arrested on unrelated charges.

5/23 - Assault - HEB. Officers were notified of an assault which occurred earlier in the day inside HEB. One subject was struck in the face by another. Suspect identified and a warrant was obtained. Subject was arrested and placed in jail.

5/25 - BPD attended mentor program at Arlon Seay Elementary.

5/25 - Criminal Mischief - Old Boerne Rd. Report taken for damage to a vehicle. Damage possibly done by a BB gun.

5/26 - Criminal Mischief - Persimmon Hill. Complainant reported a window broken on her residence. Possibly done by a golf ball.

5/27 – Civil Matter – Hwy 281. Complainant contacted officers reference a child custody issue.  
5/27 – Theft \$50-500 – HEB. Subject was detained by HEB for theft. Officers arrived and handled the incident.  
5/27 – Overdose – BSB EMS. Subject was brought to the BSB EMS building who was unconscious. Appeared subject overdosed, possibly on heroin. EMS transported the subject to a local hospital.  
5/27 – Theft \$0-50 – Bulverde Rd. Unknown subject(s) took a sign from a local business.  
5/28 – Road Rage/Threats – OVN. Complainant reported an incident on FM 1863. One subject followed the other with intentions of speaking with their parents. At one point a driver displayed a bat and made threats.  
5/28 – Disturbance – Oakland Estates. Officers responded to a disturbance between two subjects over living arrangements. Disturbance was verbal only, parties were separated.  
5/30 – Public Intoxication – Hwy 46. Caller advised their was a pickup truck sitting at the traffic light at Hwy 46 & 281, driver passed out behind the wheel. Subject was located in a local parking lot and arrested for PI.  
5/30 – Injured Person - Tetco Hwy 46. BPD was requested to respond for a subject who had fallen in the restroom and was injured. Information given was that the subject was injured while at the river.  
5/30 – Theft \$50-500 – Exxon Hwy 46. Clerk called to report theft of beer. Suspect vehicle was located on Hwy 281. Investigation revealed the clerk also played a role in the theft. Store management was advised and all subjects were identified.  
5/31 – Disturbance - Oakland Estates. Disturbance between individuals over property and the eviction process. Disturbance found to be verbal and parties were separated.
