Investigations/Significant Events:

11/01 - Criminal Mischief Persimmon Hill. Kids on a golf cart were observed throwing pumpkins at mailboxes. Juveniles were identified and parents have agreed to pay for damages.
 11/01 - Burglary Motor Vehicle. A vehicle was burglarized in the Bulverde Oaks Subdivision. No suspects identified.
 11/03 - Burglary of Habitation. A home was burglarized in the Bulverde Hills Subdivision. No suspects identified.
 11/04 - Burglary of Habitation. A home was burglarized in the Oakland Estates Subdivision. No suspects identified.
 11/04- Security provided for election locations by BPD.
 11/5-6 - Sgt Simpson in conjunction with the Comal County Fire Marshall put on a fire safety demonstration at Bill Brown and Bulverde/Rahe Elementary Schools.
 11/07 – Burglary of Habitation Bulverde Hills. Subjects entered the residence through an open sliding glass door. Possible suspects identified.
 11/07 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Two males walked in to HEB and each grabbed two 18 packs of beer. One subject was detained until officers arrived, the other fled the scene. One arrested, one warrant is being pursued on the other suspect.

11/14 – Deceased Person Windmill Ranch. 76 Year old female died of natural causes while under Hospice care.

11/17 – Burglary Habitation, Bulverde Estates. Citizen came home and observed three individuals were burglarizing his residence. Officer Barsanti located the vehicle on Hwy 281 and all three subjects. The three were arrested for burglary. Vehicle seized. A handgun was thrown from the vehicle but recovered. Property inside the vehicle was linked to other burglaries in the county.
11/19 – Amber Alert issued by CCSO for a 6 year old female. Spring Branch. Actor W/F (Mother) left scene in a light blue Hyundai 4dr. Mother and daughter located in Austin, Texas. Mother arrested and daughter placed with relatives.

11/20 – Disturbance CFS in OVN. Disturbance between a male and female. Verbal altercation only.
11/21 – Assist County on burglary at Honey Creek Store and the Silver Spur on Hwy 46.
11/25 – Check Fraud HEB. Subject attempted to write a fraudulent check, license plate obtained.
11/27 – Runaway Bulverde Hills. 15 year old female left home without parental consent. Report taken. Child returned home on 11/30.
11/28 – BPD assisted and participated in the Annual Christmas Lighting in downtown Bulverde. BPD provided traffic control and security and gave away balloons, coloring books, candy, etc.
