Investigations/Significant Events

11/11 – Criminal Mischief OVN. Complainant states someone drove a vehicle in her yard causing damage. Possible suspect identified, under investigation.

11/12 – BPD attended TxDOT grant meeting.

11/12 – BPD hosted a group of Cub Scouts at City Hall for a presentation.

11/12 – Assault on a Peace Officer. A subject was arrested for PI. While being transported to the jail he became violent. One officer was bitten by the subject.

11/13 – BPD participated in a career day event at Rahe / Bulverde Elementary.

11/13 – Theft of Service RSC. Subject fraudulently rented a piece of equipment. Suspect identified, incident is under investigation.

11/14 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject was observed shoplifting at HEB and detained. BPD arrived and cited the suspect.

11/25 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Subject attempted to push a cart of groceries out the door and fled on foot. Subject was detained by an off duty SAPD officer. Suspect was also in possession of cocaine and methamphetamine. Subject was arrested.

11/26 – Assist EMS. BPD responded to assist EMS with a non responsive subject. BPD initiated CPR until EMS arrived. Subject airlifted to local hospital in stable condition.
