Investigations/Significant Events

10/01 – BPD attended a Tazer demonstration at New Braunfels Police Department.
10/01 – Forgery-Hwy 46. Complainant states some checks were cashed on his business account. Checks were forged. Possible suspect identified and under investigation.
10/01 – BPD Warrant Detail. Warrant service at several locations around the county. 10 warrants cleared.
10/02 – Theft \$50-500 Tractor Supply. Subject entered TSC accompanied by a male and female as well as a juvenile female. While inside the store one male subject put on a pair of boots and walked out. LP was obtained, case is under investigation.
10/03 – BPD participated in a children’s event at Home Depot for a child craft / safety event for children.

10/04 – Early morning heavy rains created some flooding. BPD responded with placing barricades as needed.

10/05 – Disturbance- HEB parking lot. Officers were dispatched for a male who was observed striking a female inside a vehicle. One male was arrested for assault-B/I family violence.

10/06 – Forgery-Hwy 46. Complainant states a check was cashed on their business account for over \$8,000-Check forged. See 10/8 entry.

10/06 – BPD attended Oakland Estates HOA meeting.

10/06 – BPD participated in National Night Out. Nine separate locations throughout the city hosted block parties. Several BPD units attended each event.

10/08 – Forgery-Hwy 46. Complainant reported a vehicle in the drive thru with a male attempting to cash a possible forged check. One subject was taken into custody and another fled on foot, but was captured. Both subjects were arrested. Texas Rangers assisting Sgt. Simpson in case- third suspect identified & charges are pending. Case forwarded to DA's office.

10/08 – Threats- Oakland Estates. Complainant states she has been threatened and fears for her safety. Threat was verbal only. Suspect was issued a CTW and issued a citation for class "C" assault by threats.

10/08 – BPD attended Lion's Club meeting where Department was presented a plaque for crime prevention efforts in 2009.

10/09 - Burglary M/V Pizza Hut. Employee from Pizza Hut reported an IPOD was taken from his vehicle while he was at work. Vehicle was left unlocked in the parking lot. Under investigation.

10/11 - Fatal Accident- Hwy 46. Tractor trailer traveling east lost control and slid across Hwy 46 colliding with a passenger car traveling west. Three persons transported to UH. Passenger from car passed away later in the evening. Case forwarded to DA's office for review.

10/11 - Theft \$0-50 HEB. Suspect reportedly entered HEB and left store without paying for concealed. Subject fled the area in a pickup. BPD later observed the vehicle and a person matching the suspect description. Suspect was identified and a cited. Item recovered.

10/11 - Aggravated Assault -Oakland Estates. Dispatched for a disturbance between two females. One person was arrested for aggravated assault.

10/12 - Theft of Firearm-SR. Complainant reported a firearm stolen from his vehicle which was parked in his driveway. Vehicle was unlocked-under investigation.

10/13 – Runaway Oakland Estates. Report of a juvenile male who ran away from home. Subject returned home the next day.

10/15 - Theft \$1500-20k- Hwy 46. Complainant reported the theft of a cargo trailer loaded with furniture. Incident is under investigation.

10/15 - Assault Family Violence FM 1863. Disturbance between a male and female. Female fled the scene prior to arrival. Incident is under investigation-Non-prosecution affidavits signed. Forwarded to DA's office for review.

10/19 – BPD attended Bulverde Hills HOA meeting.

10/20 – BPD attended Oak Village North HOA meeting.

10/20 – Assist CCSO-Hwy 46. Assisted CCSO with a possible suicidal subject.

10/21 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Female subject was detained by HEB employee for shoplifting. Complainant advised the suspect had been caught at HEB before. Suspect was arrested.

10/21 – Contact made with all banks within the city reference a bank robbery which occurred in Blanco. Discussed emergency plans-Extra patrols in place.

10/21 – Disturbance-OVN. Disturbance reference a medical patient. Subject transported by EMS to the hospital for an evaluation.

10/22 – Theft \$0-50 HEB. Complainant states someone stole her purse while she was placing groceries in her vehicle. Incident is under investigation.

10/22 – BPD attended a meeting with Rahe / Bulverde Elementary staff-Discussed community policing within the school.
10/23 – Burglary of Building-Hwy 281.Dispatched to Tractor Supply for two mini-bikes that were stolen out of the yard, outside area sometime during the night.Under investigation.
10/23 – Theft \$50-500 HEB. One male subject attempted to steal several containers of detergent. When confronted by HEB staff, he ran. Subject was caught with assistance from CCSO. Transported to CCSO for Theft and drug paraphernalia.
10/23 – Purchase/Furnish Alcohol to Minors-HEB. Two males were observed purchasing & delivering alcohol to minors. Adults were found to have outstanding warrants and were transported to County Jail. Minors were issued a citation and released.
10/24 – Burglary - Subway. After closing, someone entered the store and stole the safe. No forced entry. Suspects identified and under investigation. Safe located 11/04/09.
10/24 – Theft \$500-1500-Home Depot. BPD observed two subjects loading plants into a truck after hours. Two subjects were arrested and transported.
10/24 – BPD attended BSB Library event and assisted with traffic.
10/26 – Major MVA- Hwy 46, semi vs. pickup. Three males transported to UH. Condition stable.
10/29 - PD Staff Mtg. with all Officers-New Legislation, Policies and Procedures, Discussion.
