Investigations/Significant Events

10/01 – BPD participated in a child safety event at the Bulverde Home Depot.
10/03 – BPD participated in a Comal County public health exercise.
10/03 – BPD attended a Windmill Ranch HOA meeting.
10/04 – Assist Citizen – Bulverde Oaks. Officers were dispatched reference an elderly person walking along the street who appeared disoriented. Subject was found to be an Alzheimer patient who wandered from their residence. Subject was returned home.
10/04 – Several BPD units participated in National Night Out. All block parties in the city were visited by BPD officers. Event went well.
10/06 – Hospice Death – Bulverde Hills. 70 year old male who had been diagnosed with cancer passed away while under hospice care.
10/06 – CCSO dispatch was contacted by the FAA who relayed information about a green laser light being pointed in the direction of aircraft approaching San Antonio International

Airport. It was reported in the area of OVN. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the source.

10/07 – Theft \$50-500 – HEB. Subject pumped diesel fuel and drove away without paying. A license plate was obtained and charges are pending.

10/08 – Disturbance – Oak Village North. Officers responded for a disturbance between a father and his adult son. One subject was arrested for assault and possession of marijuana.

10/11 – BPD conducted a presentation to 1st grade students at Rahe Bulverde Elementary school.

10/13 – BPD attended Bulverde Senior Center 20 year anniversary celebration.

10/13 – Overdose – Oak Village North. Subject was found unresponsive by a family member. EMS transported the subject to a local hospital where she passed away. Autopsy report pending.

10/14 – Disorderly Conduct – Exxon Kwik Check. Officers responded for a report of several juvenile subjects that were possibly intoxicated and being disorderly. Several citations issued for Class C alcohol related violations, and one person arrested for presenting an altered Texas driver's license.

10/14 – Disturbance - Sonic Drive Inn. Officers responded for a verbal disturbance between several individuals on scene. Subjects left prior to officers arriving.

10/17 – BPD attended a Bulverde Landowners HOA meeting.
