***Investigations/Significant Events:***

9/01 - Disturbance OVN. Male subject arrested for assault by contact related to Family Violence.

9/01 - MVA 400 Blk Farhills Dr. Vehicle hit a telephone pole. Driver fled on foot and was located a short time later and transported to hospital by EMS.
