Investigations/Significant Events

9/01 – BPD attended Oakland Estates HOA meeting.

9/03 – Burglary Habitation-Bulverde Estates. A vacation rental property was burglarized sometime during the week. Incident is under investigation.

9/07 – Forgery-Shepherd’s Ranch. Citizen reported she was notified by bank that checks were being passed in California. Report taken & under investigation.

9/07 – Assist EMS-Overdose-Bulverde Hills. Subject took medication and drank alcohol. Appears it was accidental. Subject transported to hospital via EMS, expected to recover.

9/25 – Assist Other Agency. BPD assisted CCSO with a vehicle pursuit of a burglary suspect on US 281. Subject arrested and transported.

9/27 – Disturbance Bulverde Hills. Officers responded for a possible disturbance outside a residence. Found to be verbal between siblings.

9/28 – Burglary MV HEB. Complainant states her purse was stolen out of her vehicle while at HEB on Saturday. Vehicle was left unlocked.

9/28 – Harassment OVN. Complainant states an individual has been making unwanted telephone calls to her phone. Under investigation.
