Investigations/Significant Events

9/01 – Budget Hearing at city hall.

9/01 – BPD participated in the Comal County DWI roll call event organized by the Comal County DA’s Office.

9/02 – Credit Card Abuse – City Hall. Business owner advised unknown subject(s) made unauthorized cash withdrawals on his bank card.

9/02 – Suicidal Subject – Bulverde Hills. Caller advised a family member had taken an unknown number of pills in an attempt to harm themselves. Subject transported via EMS to a local hospital.

9/07 – Road Rage – Hwy 281. BPD officers observed several vehicles parked in a turn around on Hwy 281. Two subjects having an altercation reference road rage. One subject was cited for assault.

9/08 – Theft \$50-500 – Local Business. Subject bought several power tools and wrote a check on a closed account.

9/08 – Motor Vehicle Crash – Hwy 46. A subject driving a motorcycle crashed into an SUV. Motorcycle operator was transported by Airlife to University Hospital and expected to recover.

9/09 – Suicidal Subject – Oakland Estates. Caller advised a subject had taken an unknown number of sleeping pills in an attempt to harm themselves. Subject had left the location prior to officer's arrival.

9/09 – Suspicious Circumstances – Bulverde Hills. Officers were dispatched for a suspicious vehicle parked in the area. Vehicle was located and contact made with three subjects. One subject was arrested for possession of marijuana. Two juveniles were released to parents.

9/09 – Motorcycle Crash – Oakland Estates. Subject on a motorcycle lost control and struck a guardrail. Driver was transported to the hospital by EMS. Alcohol was a possible factor, charges may follow.

9/10 – Bulverde Jubilee – Bulverde Jubilee event in the Village of Bulverde. BPD assisted with traffic and security. BPD handed out safety pamphlets and other items from a booth.. BPD conducted a bike rodeo at city hall and assisted as needed in other areas. Event went well.

9/10 – Criminal Mischief – Bulverde Estates. Complainant called to report possible criminal mischief to his vehicle.

9/13 – Theft \$20k-100k – Hwy 281. Complainant reported several electronics missing from a storage unit. The theft reportedly took place within three days of locking the complainant out of the storage unit for nonpayment.

9/13 – BPD attended an Oakland Estate's HOA meeting.

9/14 – Theft \$500-20k – Hwy 281. Complainant made a report for theft stating he was missing two sets of golf clubs from his storage unit.

9/20 – BPD was contacted reference found narcotics in business parking area. The owner of the narcotics was identified. An arrest warrant and a search warrant were obtained. The subject was arrested and booked into the Comal County Jail.

9/21 – Hospice Death – Oak Village North. A cancer patient in hospice care passed away.

9/20 – BPD attended an Oak Village North HOA meeting.

9/22 – Disturbance – Sonic Drive Inn Hwy 46. Management reported a subject causing a disturbance over his order. Subject left prior to officer arriving.

9/26 – Sexual Assault – Bulverde Hills. CID received information reference a possible sexual assault / family member. Incidents reportedly have occurred over the last several years. Assistance requested from DPS/Rangers.

9/26 – Criminal Trespass – Hwy 281. Complainant advised of a subject riding a go-cart on his property causing damage. Subject was located and issued a CTW for the property.
